## Respect For Holy Things

## I. Introduction

- A. Read Amos 2:1-3. Desecration of a tomb and disrespect was not their only sin but it is the one mentioned. It brought judgment on Moab.
- B. It makes me think we should have more respect and especially for God and the things of God. See Exodus 3:5 and Habakkuh 2:20.

## II. Some Things We Should Respect

- A. One area is respect for His Holy Word. Paul said, 1 Timothy 4:13.
  - 1. Consider the following incident in 2 Chronicles 34:15-21.
- 2. They had stopped listening. God expected otherwise, Deuteronomy 31:24-26; 34:9-13; 6:6-9; 17:18-20.
- 3. They did not destroy the word but lost it. Unused and unread.
- 4. It was lost in the House of God. It is possible for it to be lost in our homes and churches today.
- 5. How is the message lost today? When we do not use it and when we do not respect what it has to say. See Numbers 22:19.
  - 6. Also read 2 Thessalonians 2:10.
  - B. Another area is respect for His Holy Name.
- 1. His name cannot be taken lightly. Scribes would not say His name out loud and would use a new quill each time they wrote it.
- 2. We need to seriously consider our words. OMG is taking His name in vain.
- 3. Also we must make sure that we do not consider 'Lord' lightly. If He is our lord He is our master. Cannot be 'Not so, Lord' as in Acts 10:14.
  - 4. Jesus said, "Luke 6:46."

## III. Conclusion

- A. Read Isaiah 6:1-5. When he caught a glimpse of God's glory it changed his outlook on everything.
  - B. Then it became 'Here am I, send me." And so it will be with us.
